Education Law relates to the laws governing educational bodies and school systems and deals with schools (at all levels, including institutions of higher education), teachers, and the right to a public education. Education law also deals with discrimination in education and special education. Both the federal government and the states enact and enforce education laws, and attorneys who practice in this area gain familiarity with administrative law as well as statutory law and case law.



Students in Loyola's Youth Justice Education Clinic pursue education service and reform as they represent students in the Los Angeles Unified School District.

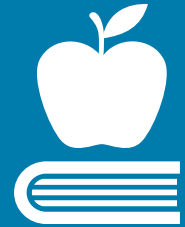
